Applications are now open until 31 May 2017 for schools wishing to register as a DELF Scolaire participating school in 2017.

What is a participating school?

DELF Scolaire exams are held in schools accredited as DELF examination centres (see list of current accredited centres below). Other schools can have their students sit the exam in an accredited centre by registering as *participating schools*.

Why do schools have to register?

Students who want to sit the DELF scolaire cannot register individually with an exam centre. They have to register through their own school. Exam centres will only accept candidates from participating schools registered with them for a given exam session.

What are the requirements to become a participating school?

Any school can apply. It is not necessary for participating schools to have DELF accredited teachers among their staff at the time of registration - although it is recommended that at least one teacher should become accredited in due course. Registration is free of charge.

Why is it important to register early?

Early registration of participating schools ensures that candidate numbers can be anticipated well ahead of the session so that exams are run smoothly and efficiently.

Please note that registration of participating schools is not automatic and is subject to the capacity of exam centres.
